Currently, there are 120 kids from all over the community between the ages of 10 and 15 years old coming out on a weekly basis.

These talks correspond with the take-home challenges that the kids take home each week.

Parents are encouraged to read over and discuss the papers with their children, and are welcome to come and listen to the talk given.

The volunteers of Breakaway hope to inspire the kids involved to make right choices, using an incentive program and prizes.
